#### Coach Rob King



Coach King is in his 11th year as the Head Coach of the KSU Soccer Team. The KSU Soccer Team is one of the strongest programs in the Atlantic Sun Conference. In 2011, three of the Owls were named to the A-Sun All Conference Teams. The Owls have won the A-Sun regular season Championship three times and been a NCAA Tournament

participant twice.

Over the previous nine seasons, Coach King lead the Owls to be the dominant force in the Atlantic Sun Conference and the Peach Belt Conference. The Owls won the NCAA II National Championship in 2003. Coach King was awarded the NSCAA/adidas Southeast Region Coach of the Year and NSCAA/adidas National Coach of the Year in 2003.


